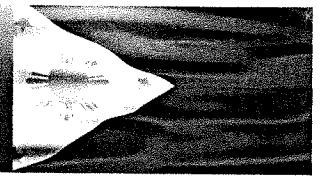

Locked Down and Looking Up

Greetings from the Philippines!

Our church here in the Philippines supports about 30 Filipino missionaries who are serving all over the world. It is my joy, of course, to read their prayer letters as they share what God has been doing in their ministries. I have, however, noticed a trend in those letters as our missionaries struggle to report during this COVID-19 Pandemic. They are faithfully trying to communicate with their partners, but searching for the right things to say. I have chuckled a little as I have read the letters which redundantly say we are locked down, forbidden to have services, doing our best to survive and praying that this will all be over soon. I chuckle because they are doing their best to put a positive spin on a difficult situation. Now it's my turn. Ha Ha

I will start by saying that the church offerings and missions giving have thrived during these difficult days. We were banned from having gatherings for almost three months, but somehow the people found a way to deliver their tithes and offerings. I have taught our people that they are responsible for their church and that the general operations budget must come from their tithes. They have proved themselves faithful during these difficult times. The surplus has grown and we are a little ahead of last year in our missions giving. Most of our people have not been able to work and I cannot comprehend it humanly speaking. But God is faithful!

Things are getting a little better here as they have modified the quarantine. Several folks are able to make it to the services now, but those who are 60+ and those 20 and below are still under a home quarantine. Our staff is able to get around a visit the families and our teachers are visiting the students throughout the week. It sure will be nice when we can get back to our regular routine.

Barb is still with her parents and we're just not sure when we can get her back. Foreigners cannot return yet. Her mother is doing much better now, but her dad became very sick and has been in the hospital. So we thank the Lord that she could be with them both during these difficult times. And Heidi was able to visit them, as well.

We continue to make good use of the downtime by doing construction here inside the compound. We have almost completed the preparation for the 6 container houses for which we have been praying. God has provided the funding and I'm hoping to order them next week. It will be a big blessing when our staff move into these houses!



The church will be 16 years old in a couple of weeks. There won't be much we can do about having an anniversary celebration this year. Our folks are sad about skipping our anniversary traditions. Lord willing, we can plan it for next year and just make it twice as exciting!

I want to take a moment and thank all of you for staying faithful during these challenging days. We have felt it, of course, but we are doing just fine and God is proving himself faithful. We are so thankful for your sacrifice and investment in the ministry here. I know that everyone is having a hard time right now, but you have made it possible for us to serve with out interruption. Thank you!

As always, It's a great time to be alive!
